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

# 4K Shared Governance Model Description

## I. Councils

- Practice
- Environmental
- Staffing and Scheduling
- Reward and Recognition
- Peer Review

## **II. Communication Processes**

- Minutes are recorded and retained electronically in a shared folder.
- Each council provides an update at unit meetings.

## III. Unit Staff Member Requirements

- All staff members are expected to participate in at least one council.
- Attendance requirements are determined by each council.

## IV. Selection Process for Council Memberships

- Opportunities for memberships are posted annually for staff sign-up.
- Members are selected by current council members in collaboration with the unit leadership.
- Council Chairpersons
  - selected by council members via a nomination and majority vote process.
  - may not be in the disciplinary action process.
  - must have served on the designated council for one year immediately prior to nomination.
  - must have completed the leadership development workshop on meeting facilitation
  - is in the role of chair-elect one year before assuming the chair role for one year.

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
