Excursion to Atlantic City.

The Allentown motormen and conductors of the Lehigh Valley Traction Company will run an all-rail excursion via the Central and Pennsylvania Railroads to Atlantic City on Sunday, August 11, for the benefit of the Allentown Hospital. The fare will be \$2.25. Stops will be made at every station between Mauch Chunk and Easton. The train will leave Allentown at 6 a. m. and arrive at Atlantic City at 9 a. m. The train will leave Atlantic City for home at 7 p. m. The excursion will probably be run in two sections to accommodate the people and make fast time. Refreshment cars will be attached. The motormen and conductors ran a very successful excursion for their own benefit to Coney Island last year, and will do all in their power to make the coming excursion even more successful, so as to be able to send a nice check to the hospital.
