HOSPITAL GETS \$15,000.

The Appropriation Was Cut \$5000 by the Governor.

Senator Stiles yesterday received a telegram from Governor Stone announcing that he allowed the Allentown Hospital \$15,000 of \$20,000 made by the legislature. The governor is said to have decided upon lopping off half the sum, but at the solicitation of Senator Stiles, Dr. C. S. Martin, Alderman Jones and others he cut off only a quarter.

The governor also approved an appropriation of \$20,000 for St. Luke's Hospital.
