Important Information About Your Pay

As 2018 begins, please review your January paycheck, which can be accessed through Ultipro, to make sure the deductions and other amounts are correct. Ultipro also has pertinent information about health and welfare plans and other important information. It can be accessed from the intranet and internet. To access Ultipro, enter your first initial and last name, followed by your password. If you have any concerns, please contact human resources at ext. 3360 and select the appropriate number for assistance.

PTO cash out

Colleagues who are cashing out PTO (up to 48 hours) will be paid during the Jan. 18 pay period. If you have a balance of more than 200 hours after the cash out, you will have that time automatically cashed out at 50 percent in that same pay.

Tax forms

Colleagues will receive W2s and 1095C information mailed to their home by the end of January. W2 information also will be accessible in Ultipro by the end of January.

Wellness reimbursement

If you completed the Wellness Program in 2017, please note that the wellness reimbursement will not appear in your Jan. 4 pay. Payroll was unable to process the reimbursement at the time. Therefore, two reimbursements will be made in your Jan. 18 pay.
