- Distributed a folder containing a compilation of brochures on grief and loss
- Resulted in a plethora of information that was often overwhelming to families
- Challenged to develop a single, comprensive resource guide that is "user-friendly"





Coping with the Loss of Your Child


- Written information assists family in the time immediately following the death including:
 - Arranging your child's funeral
 - FAQ's about children, death and funerals
 - Chidlren's FAQ's about death and funerals
- DVD contains additional information essential to processing the loss of a child:
 - Personal stories of coping and loss from bereaved families and staff
 - What is grief?
 - Living with the loss of your child
 - Step-parent and grandparent grief
 - Services beyond the hospital

Lessons Learned

- Recognize that families in crisis are often unable to process much of the information given to them
- Involve bereaved families in the development of a comprehensive grief resource guide

Future Steps

- Translate resource guide and DVD into Spanish
- Create additional resource guides:
 - Staff education to assist a child's family during the final stages of life
 - "Helping Children Cope with the Loss of a Loved One"
