Video Remote Interpretation Services

Lehigh Valley Hospital (LVH)–Hazleton and Lehigh Valley Physician Group (LVPG)–Hazleton colleagues partnered with the Lehigh Valley Hospital (LVH) Interpreter and Information Services Departments and the vendor, Stratus, to provide Video Remote Interpretation (VRI) Services. The go-live was completed on June 8 and included LVH–Hazleton, the Health & Wellness Center at Hazleton, the Health Center at Mountain Top, ExpressCARE and LVPG–Hazleton locations. The 65 iPads™ are securely mounted to a moveable stand with various height and angle adjustments.

The VRI service is delivered through mobile wireless iPads, and currently supports 20 video languages, including American Sign Language interpretation and 215 audio languages.
