
This includes the Find a Doctor database listing of our providers and services, by far the most popular feature on the site.

The decision to merge the two sites followed interviews with community members in the greater Hazleton and Mountain Top

areas. They expressed a preference for a common site with information cataloging all of LVHN's services and locations as opposed to having to navigate between two sites for information. The site merger also is consistent with our merger goal of one mission, one brand and one consistent health care experience.
