

To be eligible to win, you must participate in our biometric screenings for blood pressure (BP) and body mass index (BMI). Screenings take just minutes and are an important barometer of your overall health and well-being. To complete your screenings:

- You can self-report your BP and BMI to employee health if you've already been screened by your primary care provider (PCP) within the past six months. Simply download the Biometric Screening form and email the completed form to Heather.Childress@lvhn.org or fax it to employee health (610-402-1203).
- Get screened by your PCP and fax in the results on the biometric screen form (610-402-1203).
- Visit employee health during walk-in hours.
- Ask your department head to call 610-402-CARE. If your department has 16 or more colleagues who've committed to being screened, a registered nurse will come to your department in January or February.
- Exercise physiologists and athletic trainers at LVHN Fitness and Steel Fitness can conduct screenings too. Colleagues can get screened at LVHN Fitness during select hours whether or not you are a member. Screenings also are taking place at Steel Fitness for gym members only. Visit the registration desk at a gym near you to schedule your screening.

\*Two Grand Prize winners will be drawn from our entire pool of entrants on June 30, 2015. In addition to monthly Fitbit prizes and February Heart Month prizes, there also will be impromptu prize drawings through the end of the fiscal year.



## You Asked, We Listened; LVHN Fitness— Muhlenberg to Expand Evening Hours Starting Feb. 9

In her recent "Terry's Take" blog here on Mission Central, chief operating officer Terry Capuano, RN, encouraged colleagues to stay well by using their Culture of Wellness benefit program and working out at LVHN Fitness. In response, several colleagues at Lehigh Valley Hospital (LVH) -Muhlenberg who regularly work past 7 p.m. weeknights expressed concern about being unable to get to our LVHN Fitness-Muhlenberg location prior to its 8 p.m. closing time. At the same time, colleagues



also mentioned this same topic during leadership rounds at LVH-Muhlenberg.

Since you asked, we listened. Now, starting next Monday (Feb. 9), the LVHN Fitness location at the Health & Wellness Center at Muhlenberg (1770 Bathgate Road) will be open until 9 p.m. on weeknights. This will allow colleagues who work until 7 p.m. ample time to and body mass index. hit the fitness center after work.

Starting Feb. 9, the facility's new hours will be:

- Mon.-Fri. 5 a.m. to 9 p.m.
- Sat.-Sun. 7 a.m.-3:30 p.m.

"When Terry shared with us our colleagues' concerns at LVH-Muhlenberg, we worked with our staff here at LVHN Fitness—Muhlenberg and found a way to stay open later," says Craig Souders, LVHN's director of rehabilitation, who oversees our LVHN Fitness locations. "By expanding our weeknight hours, we're making it easier for those colleagues to plan for a full workout."

With this change, all three LVHN Fitness locations (at Cedar Crest, Muhlenberg and One City Center) now are open until 9 p.m. weeknights.





# Robert Budinetz, MD, Wants to Help You Prevent Health Problems – VIDEO


