LVH–Pocono, Monroe County’s cancer care leader, is advancing the level of cancer care available to patients right in their community. During an 11 a.m. news conference, we announced that [Lehigh Valley Cancer Institute’s membership in the Memorial Sloan Kettering \(MSK\) Cancer Alliance is extending to Monroe County](#) at the Dale and Frances Hughes Cancer Center at LVH–Pocono. During the event, LVHN and MSK leaders explain how the Alliance will bring groundbreaking cancer care closer to where people live in Monroe County. “Bringing all that the MSK Cancer Alliance has to

offer to the Hughes Cancer Center, which is the region’s first and leading cancer care facility, takes the care offered in this community to yet another level,” says LVHN President and Chief Executive Officer Brian Nester, DO, MBA, FACOEP.
