NEARLY READY FOR ROOF**

The new nurses' home at the hospital at the southeast corner of Seventeenth and Chew streets, is nearly ready for the roof. The bricklayers have reached the cornice. It is an imposing looking building, 45 by 154 feet in dimensions and three stories high. The contract price of the Ochs Construction Co. is \$73,453. Ground was broken October 14, 1914.
