BOARD OF VISITORS FILES ANNUAL REPORT

The Allectown Hospital has a capacity of 181 beds and at the time of the last visit was caring for 140 patients. From 70 per cent to 72 per cent of these are charity patients. The equipment of the hospital is com-

plete and up to date.

The sun parlor on the roof has been equipped and is in continuous use, largely for children with tubercular affections other than pulmonary. Apparatus for the purifying and pasteuring of the milk has also been installed. A splendid Home for Nurses' is being built and will fill a serious need.
