Mr. Smith, the regional representative for Sensor Card System demonstrated his company's card access door security system. He indicated that this sytem could be expanded, and that with the installation of one microprocessor unit in the library, it would be possible to hook up a second reader within 1000 feet (i.e. pharmacy) .

The report generated by the system would indicate whose card accessed the system and at what time. It would also indicate whether an unauthorized card tried to gain access. The system is flexible in that it can be programmed to prevent violators from future entry.

Brad Waldman will investigate the versatility of the sensor card as a general hospital identification card and its compatibility with future security systems.
