PUBLIC INVITED TO NURSES' GRADUATION

Excellent Program for Thursday Night at Lyric Theatre.

The commencement of the Allentown Hospital Training School for Nurses to be held to-morrow evening in the Lyric Theatre will be open to the general public and the authorities extend a most cordial invitation to the people to attend. No seats will be reserved but it will be a case of first come first served. It is hoped that the theatre will be crowded for the occasion. The event is worthy of it. The speakers are two of the ablest surgeons in the country. Drs. Keen and Baldy have a wide reputation as surgeons. Dr. W. W. Keen is emeritus professor of surgery at the Jefferson Medical College in Philadelphia. Dr. J. M. Baldy is president of the state board of examiners and is professor of gynecology at the Polyclinic College and Hospital in Philadelphia. The local hospital, will present the diplomas to the fifteen graduates and Secretary A. Samuels, of the board of trustees, will read the statistics. The opening prayer will be by Rev. Dr. J. M. G. Darms and the benediction by Very Rev. Peter Masson. The music for the commencement will be by the Allentown Band.
