PHYSICIAN PARKING UPDATE - TAH SITE

Effective Monday, June 18, physician parking will be located in the lot across the street from Merchants Bank at the corner of 17th and Chew Streets. Access to the lot will be available only with the Hospital photo I.D. cards which have been encoded by the Security Department. For the first few weeks that this new system is in effect, Security will be stationed at the gate to allow physicians to enter the

GYN EXAM ROOM AVAILABLE ON 7B AT LVHC SITE

In order to provide patient privacy for gyn/pelvic consults and to obtain vaginal cultures, smears, pap tests, and endometrial biopsies for in-house patients, a GYN examination room has been available on 7B at the LVHC site since December, 1988.

To schedule a patient for the room, the physician requesting the exam will notify the unit where the patient is located of the time requested and the procedure to be performed. A minimum of one hour notice is required between the time the request is made until the time the procedure is performed.

The unit will inform the physician if the patient will be available at the time requested. If not, the unit and physician will identify another time mutually acceptable. The unit

is responsible for calling 7B with the name of the patient, physician, scheduled time, and procedure to be completed. If the room is not available at the time the physician requested, he or she should be contacted immediately to schedule another time.

The patient's unit is responsible to transport the patient to 7B with chart and addressograph plate. The patient should arrive a minimum of ten minutes before procedure is to begin. The charge nurse on 7B is responsible for coordinating the schedule to accommodate all persons involved.

**Vascular Doppler Studies in
Radiology**

In last month's newsletter, the Vascular Laboratory announced that OPG's, Arterial Doppler, and Venous Doppler studies to be performed at TAH site will now be scheduled by the secretary in the Vascular Lab at the LVHC site.

PLEASE NOTE - This policy does not apply to vascular doppler studies done in the Department of Radiology at TAH site, which continues to schedule and perform both in- and out-patient doppler services. These services include color duplex doppler evaluation of extra cranial carotid arteries, upper and lower extremity veins for thrombosis or pre-op mapping, portal veins and other deep intra-abdominal veins and arteries, and arteries for aneurysm, pseudo-aneurysm, or arterio-venous fistula.

A full range of ultrasound, CT, and x-ray services are also available. For scheduling, call 778-2214 for x-rays, and 778-2450 for CT-ultrasound.

L.E.A.R.N. Weight Control

L.E.A.R.N. is a 10-week multi-faceted approach to successful weight control that is structured around the participant's lifestyle. The program is designed to help participants identify and change daily patterns to lose weight, and most importantly, to keep it off. The sessions take a positive approach in stressing change in five key areas: Lifestyle, Exercise, Attitudes, Relationships, Nutrition.
