Services at the City Hospital.

Services were conducted at the Allentown Hospital Sunday afternoon by Rev. Dr. G. A. Schwedes at 3.30 o'clock, assisted by Prof. Unger and a double quartet of Salem Reformed Church. They were taken to the hospital in autos by George M. Lutz and Herb. J. Hunsicker. The services at the Hospital are under direction of the Surgeon-in-chief Dr. Chas. D. Schaeffer, and will be held under the auspices of the City Ministerial Association. These services will be greatly enjoyed by the internes and nurses who are off-duty during the hour, and the convalescent patients, quite a number of whom could be present yesterday. The hospital is pleasantly equipped at present for these services, which are conducted in the large and roomy library of the Administration Building; a chapel organ having been presented by the Aschbach Music House, and a hundred copies of the Sunday School Hymnal by Mrs. Lawfer, the cover of the hymnals bearing the memorial inscription in gilt letters "Alvin W. Lawfer." These hymnals contain the largest number of familiar standard hymns, by actual count of several such hymn-collections, and will therefore be best adapted for inter-denominational use.

Rev. Dr. Steimle will conduct the service next Sunday afternoon at 3.30 assisted by members of the St. John Lutheran choir.
