MEDICO-CHI. GRADUATES,

Drs. Druckenmiller and Minner Will Come to the Allentown Hospital.

Diplomas were granted to 204 graduates of the Medico-Chirurgical College at the thirtieth annual commencement exercises in the Philadelphia Academy of Music Friday. It was the largest class in the history of the institution, and comprised 85 students from the medical department, 45 in dentistry, 53 from the department of pharmacy and 17 from the department of pharmaceutical chemistry.

Degrees were conferred upon 83 graduates by Henry F. Walton, President of the Board of Trustees.

Drs. Stanley F. Druckenmiller and Jonas E. S. Minner, of the class, were assigned to the Allentown Hospital as internes for the year opening July 1.
