Law and the Emergency Room

Noted author, physician, and lawyer, James George, M.D., J.D., will be the featured speaker on Thursday, June 12, 8:30 A.M., in the Hospital Center Auditorium for a one-day educational program on legal aspects of the Emergency Room.

Designed for Emergency Physicians, nurses, and administrators, the program will include discussions on general legal principles, duty to treat, consent, Good Samaritan Laws, blood alcohol and police problems, child abuse, triage, rape, psychiatric emergencies, malpractice insurance and more.

Dr. George is the author of "Emergency Care and the Law" and has co-authored "Emergency Department Organization and Management" and "Principles and Practice of Emergency Medicine."

Dr. George received his medical training at University of Louisville School of Medicine and legal training at University of Louisville School of Law.

He is on the Board of Directors of the American College of Emergency Physicians, the Director of the Medical Society of New Jersey, Department of Liability Control, a Fellow with the American College of Legal Medicine, and presides as Vice Speaker for the Medical Society of New Jersey's House of Delegates.

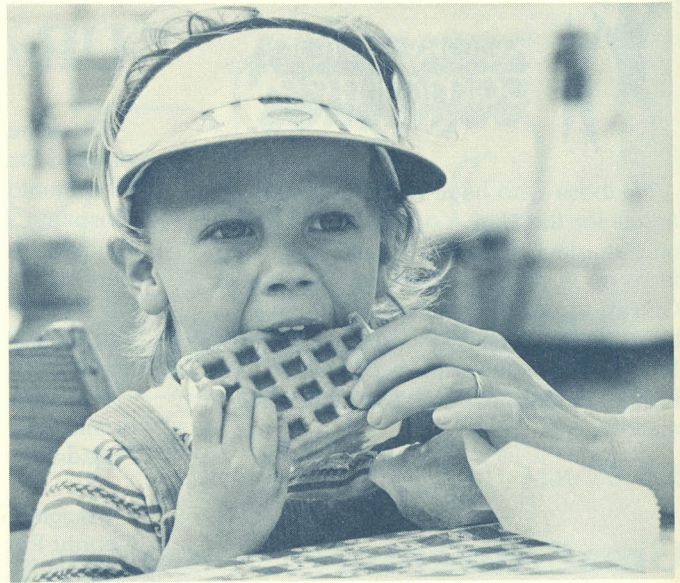
