During the Past Few Weeks.

The City of Cleveland Has 14 Hos-
pitals -- Allentown Has How
Many?--A Site Has Been
Offered Free of Cost.

In a report of the different enterprises of the city of Cleveland, O., there appears among the list: HOSPITALS, 14. Cleveland has a population of 340,000. Allentown, with a population of 30,000, has none.

A few kind-hearted people, stimulated by the efforts of THE MORNING CRITIC to raise a fund sufficient to build a hospital, have subscribed to the fund. Harry C.
