FOR THE HOSPITAL.

The Committee of the Board of Trustees is Formulating a Good Plan.

Yesterday morning a committee of the Board of Trustees of the Hospital Association set to work formulating plans for a grand concert to be rendered in two sections the same day at two different places. The committee has engaged the Academy of Music and Central Market Hall for the places of holding the concerts on February 11. The Alientown Band and the Euterpean Club have offered their services free of charge and each member of these organizations will pay an admission fee of one dollar besides. The price of admission will be \$1.

Five thousand tickets will be issued. All the printing matter will be donated to this grand cause. The Academy of Music and Central Market Hall have been secured rent free. Several men have also offered their services as ushers for the occasion, paying \$1 for the privilege, so that the gross receipts of the two concerts will all be devoted to the hospital fund.
