Charters Recorded.

Two charters have been put on record in Recorder Benner's office. One for the Allentown Hospital and the Madock Slate Co. at Slatington. The shareholders in the latter: Morris Pierce, of Slatington; T. E. J. Scharbby and Walter E. Scharbby, of Brooklyn; Thomas Morgan, of Jefferson county; W. P. Davies, John L. Anwal, John Edwards, of Northampton; Robert G. Davies, of Slatington, and C. R. James, of Allentown. The capital stock of the company is \$10,000.
