TO SELL THE CITY'S LOT

City Property and Water Committees Met Last Night.

Reported Favorably Upon the Ordinance to Sell Reservoir Lot—The Hospital Ordinance Amended

. With Doctors' Clause.

The City Property and Water Committees of Councils met last evening and reported favorably upon the ordinance to sell the city lot for hospital purposes.

The ordinance is amended with the doctors' clause, allowing physicians of both schools of medicines to practice in the hospital. At the same time the City Solicitor is asked to give an opinion with reference to the city's right to sell the property.
