- A focus on collaboration, innovative relationships, and creation of novel programs; this includes our merger with Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer, growth of telehealth and the development of our Innovation Center

In truth, most of what we have done has had very little to do with me. It is instead the result of tremendous work by the many talented leaders and team members in the network – individuals who often our medical staff members.

In parting, I have little advice other than we need to continue to advance but also not forgot what's made us great since our doors first opened at the original Allentown Hospital in 1899. Innovation, optimizing efficiency and access to technology are important, but our foundation is founded on – and must continue to be focused on –

# Allied Health Staff Biennial Reappointment

In compliance with the regulations of the Pennsylvania Department of Health, the Medical Staff and Hospital Bylaws, the standards of the Healthcare Facilities Accreditation Program (HFAP) and The Joint Commission (TJC), each member of the hospital's Allied Health Professional staff must be reappointed a minimum of once every two years.

On Jan. 1, 2019, next year's biennial reappointment process will be put into motion when reappointment applications will be available for more than 950 members of the Allied Health Professional staff.

Directions for completing the reappointment application process will be included with the application notice sent to the provider. This new reapplication process will have data screens requiring the practitioner to review the current data and add or change as appropriate. The practitioner should review the directions provided to make sure all the information is completely addressed and arrangements for submission of all the required documents have been made. This information will serve as both the official and confidential file for the Medical Staff Services office and the network.

The deadline to return reappointment applications is Jan. 20, 2019.

# LUCAS Chest Compression Devices Coming to Lehigh Valley Heart Institute

As part of the launch of Lehigh Valley Heart Institute's (LVHI) Cardiogenic Shock program, four LUCAS devices were purchased for the emergency departments at Lehigh Valley Hospital (LVH)—Schuylkill, LVH—Hazleton, LVH—17th Street and the Cardiac Catheterization Laboratory at LVH—Pocono.

The LUCAS mechanical chest compression device provides external and automated chest compressions (CPR) on patients experiencing cardiac arrest. The \$62,000 investment from LVHI's technology fund allows providers to provide high quality, consistent compressions to sudden cardiac arrest patients as they are moved within the hospital and in the event a patient requires a transport to another hospital within the network.

Without a LUCAS device, sustaining life saving circulation is performed through traditional (manual) means. It is resource intensive, physically demanding for those performing CPR, and can make moving patients while performing CPR logistically difficult. A LUCAS device allows providers to overcome many challenges, particularly in patients requiring emergent invasive procedures such as percutaneous coronary intervention in a cath lab.


# There's Still Time to Take Wellness Based Index Survey

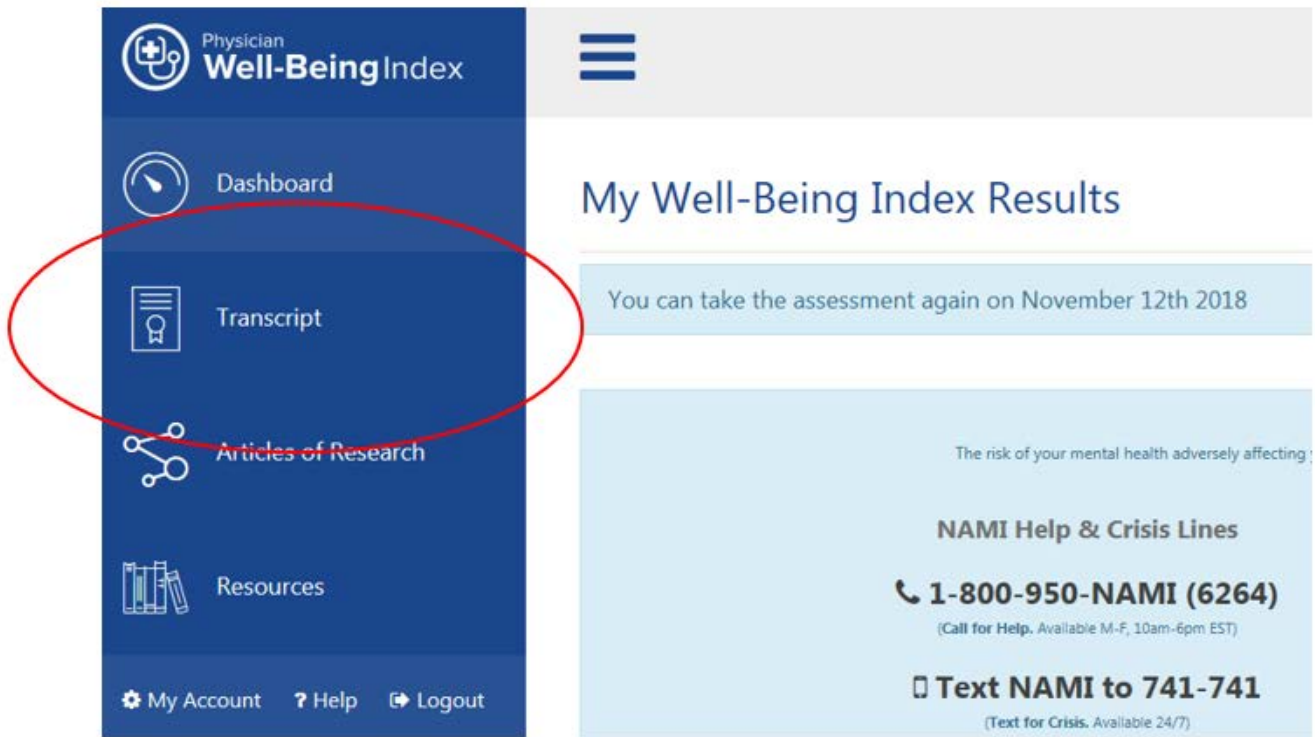

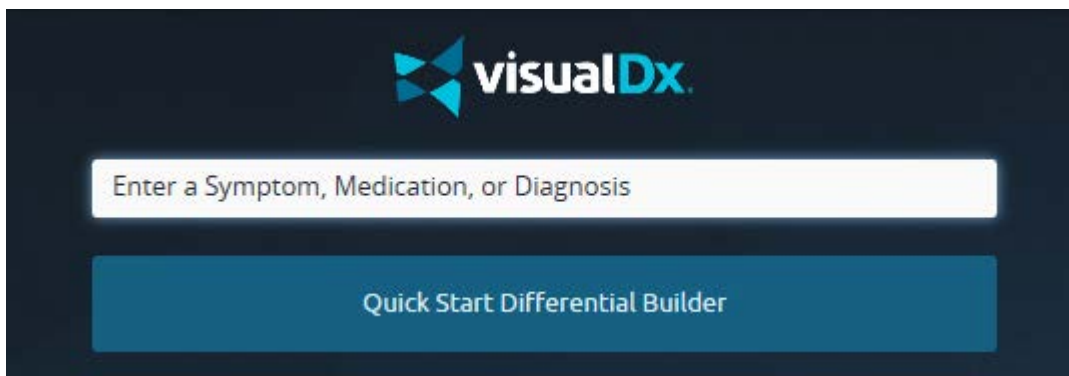

# VisualDX: A Diagnostic Decision Support System

The VisualDX database is a diagnostic decision support system designed to aid medical professionals in the diagnosis of visually identifiable diseases.

- It contains more than 29,000 images representing more than 1,300 visually identifiable diseases, drug reactions and infections.



Users can begin by entering in a symptom, medication or diagnosis. The user will receive questions in order to narrow down the diagnosis. It consists of:

1. Differential builder
  2. ICD-10 codes
  3. Diagnosis synopsis
  4. Diagnostic Pearls
  5. Differential diagnosis & pitfalls
  6. Best tests
  7. Management pearls
  8. Therapy
- CME is included in the VisualDX. Each time you use VisualDX to build a differential or look up a diagnosis, you will accrue potential CME credit earning 0.5 AMA PRA Category 1 credits. To earn and claim these credits you must create a personal login and be logged in while performing your search.
  - VisualDX provides rapid access to rare diagnoses, such as CDC Category A, B and C bioterrorism agents; chemical and radiation injuries; and uncommon infectious diseases.
  - Users may share information about a disease with a colleague who is not part of Lehigh Valley Health Network (LVHN) and does not have a license. A temporary link that can be accessed for 15 days will be sent to the colleague.
  - Mobile access: You can also access the database through your mobile device. Visit the VisualDX page and

click on the mobile app and follow the directions.


