The Hospital Excursion to Mountain Park on July 25.

The Allentown Hospital excursion will leave for Mountain Park July 25 on the Jersey Central Railroad. It is expected that this will be one of the largest excursions that ever issued from Allentown. Mountain Park will be reached by 9 a. m. and a short walk brings one to the "Spring of the village of pleasure." The most striking feature of the park is the excellent management. Every night the attendants clean it thoroughly and get it in readiness for the next day's excursionists; they also transfer the baggage to the park for the pleasure seekers. There are a splendid kitchen and hot stoves and plenty of ice at the disposal of the guests. All along the mountain are delightful paths and roads that are well kept, and on the mountain top the German shooting clubs of Wilkes-Barre have their annual shoot at a wooden bird placed on a pole hundreds of feet in the air. The prize is \$225 and the winner is entitled to the name, "king of the marksmen," for a year. Who does not wish to see Hermit's cave, one of the most interesting spots imaginable?
