### THE HOSPITAL SITE.

**The Purchase of the Ground Ratified  
Yesterday Afternoon.**

The board of trustees of the Allentown Hospital Association met yesterday afternoon and accepted the tract of land bounded by Seventeenth, Gordon, Chew and West streets for a hospital site. The tract contains nearly three acres and covers half of a square. This is the tract bought at the Greisemer sale on Tuesday by H. S. Shimer, Henry Leh, Frank S. Trexler and Colonel H. C. Trexler for \$5400.

The twenty per cent. was ordered to be paid at once and the remainder of the money will be paid on May 1, when the deed will be delivered to the association. Hon. Edward Harvey, Rev. G. W. Richards and Dr. W. H. Hartzell were appointed a committee to procure designs for the hospital building. It is likely that building will begin in the early summer.
