Rev. Dr. J. A. Singmaster, Dr. W. H. Hartzell, James F. Hunsicker, H. S. Shimer, John E. Lentz, Rev. Dr. S. A. Repass, Rev. Geo. W. Richards, John B. Gossler, and Dr. Orlando Fegley, trustees of the Allentown Hospital Association, met yesterday afternoon and adopted the English colonial style of architecture in preference to the American colonial. The former is also by far the handsomer. It is the intention at present to lay only the foundation walls and not commence on the building proper until next spring.
