The Finance Committee Has Still Further Reduced the Estimates.

The finance committee of councils last evening applied the pruning knife and cut down appropriations so as to bring it within the within the present tax rate. The following items were stricken off. Repair to Hibernia hose house \$600; repairs to Allen engine house, \$800; repairs to Rescue house, \$100; grading of Fifteenth street, from Turner to Chew, \$1100; repair of Washington street, from Tilghman to Sumner avenue, \$100. The item labor and carting was reduced from \$6500 to \$4000. The item of cinders ~~\$2000~~ was added. The committee exempted the hospital property from taxes.

Morris Becker was appointed to assist City Typewriter Sterner in making the tax duplicate. They also granted the vouchers for the payment of the city assessors.
