## HOSPITAL FAIR RECEIPTS.

The Ladies' Auxiliary Will Net \$3890.16 Through the Affair. The hospital fair held by the Ladies' Auxiliary of the Association from February 19 to 26 netted \$3890.16. The expenses were \$544.30, leaving a balance of \$3345.86, of which some \$30 only is outstanding.
