On the evenings of November 10 and 11 the Ladies' Auxiliary of the Allentown Hospital Association will present, with the assistance of about 300 participants, at the Academy of Music, the "Great Republic," a descriptive performance of the history of this country from the time of its discovery by Columbus in 1492 to Dewey at Manila Bay, 1898.
