Smith, Frank Kline, W. H. Wolf; delegates to the Allentown Firemen's Relief Association, William H. Wolf, William Morrell, O. T. Weaver; delegates to the Four County Firemen's Association, James L. Schaadt; alternate, William H. Ott; delegate to State Firemen's Association, A. L. Reichenbach; alternate, O. T. Weaver.

The following was offered by Captain James L. Schaadt and adopted by the company last evening ~~relative to furnishing a~~ ward in the Allentown Hospital:

Resolved, That the ~~the~~ president of this company be directed to confer with the presidents of the several companies of this department relative to furnishing a ward for the Allentown [Hospital] and that he be given full power to act. The sum to be expended, however, not to exceed thirty-five (\$35) dollars.

A circular letter has been addressed to all the companies, and it is thought that all will follow with similar action.
