THE HOSPITAL DOCTORS CHOSEN

The regular monthly meeting of the board of trustees of the Allentown Hospital Association was held yesterday afternoon in council chamber. The members in attendance were: Rev. Dr. J. A. Singmaster, John R. Gossler, Dr. C. S. Martin, Dr. C. D. Schaeffer, Dr. W. H. Hartzell, A. Samuels, W. P. Moyer, R. S. Lisenring, Rev. Dr. S. A. Repass, James Hunsicker, Dr. Orlando Fegely.

William P. Moyer was appointed a committee to request of council the use of council chamber for the meetings of the board. The following resolution by Rev. Dr. S. A. Repass and R. S. Lisenring was adopted: "Resolved, That the board of trustees of the Allentown Hospital Association extends its thanks to A. N. Ulrich, of Catawauqua, for the kindness and valuable assistance given the committee in soliciting contributions and donations for the hospital fund, and to convey the assurance of the most grateful feeling and appreciation for the results obtained."

Assistant nurses for the hospital were elected as follows: Miss Laura Miesmer, of this city, a graduate of the Methodist Episcopal Hospital, Philadelphia, and Miss M. J. Yost, of Bethlehem. A committee, Messrs. A. Samuels and R. S. Lisenring, was empowered to employ a cook and laundry woman for the hospital. The finance committee was empowered to make all necessary loans, temporarily, not to exceed \$3000.

The election of a surgical and medical staff was next proceeded with. The elections resulted as follows: Chief surgeon, Dr. Orlando Fegely; assistant surgeons, Drs. C. D. Schaeffer, Alfred J. Yost, Daniel Hiestand, Roderick E. Albright; physician-in-chief, Dr. W. H. Hartzell; assistant physicians, Charles S. Martin, H. H. Harist, C. J. Otto, I. F. Huebner; ophthalmologist, or eye physician, Dr. George F. Seibeling; pathologist, Dr. M. F. Cawley; consulting surgeons, Drs. John B. Deaver, Philadelphia; H. Y. Horn, Coplay; consulting physicians, Drs. H. H. Riegel, Catawauqua; W. B. Erdman, Macungie.

The building committee was authorized to procure awnings for the building.

On Monday, May 22, the hospital will be opened to receive patients. As will be seen above the finance committee is empowered to make loans not to exceed \$3000. It is earnestly desired, however, that the committee be required to make as few and as small loans as possible. The charitably inclined public is again appealed to for funds to complete the furnishing of the building. Those who made promises of donations are reminded that their articles are urgently needed at this time.
