A Social Affair for the Benefit of the Hospital.

One of the pleasantest social affairs of the ante-Lenten season in the city was held last evening in Lehigh Valley Hall, where a dance was given under the auspices of Misses Sallie Mertz, Emma, Carrie and Mame Schlechter for the benefit of the Allentown Hospital fund.
