The \$10,000 Allowed.

In the report made by the state board of charities the \$10,000 asked for by the Allentown Hospital is allowed. St. Luke's, at South Bethlehem, requested \$40,000 and is given \$25,000. The Easton Hospital is cut down from \$23,000 to \$15,000. The Easton Home for Aged Women is reduced from \$6000 to \$5000.
