APPROPRIATION ACTS,

No. 179-A.

AN ACT

Making an appropriation to the trustees of the Milliken Hospital, Pottsville, Pennsylvania.

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That the sum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby specifically appropriated to the trustees of the Milliken Hospital, at Pottsville, Pennsylvania, for the two fiscal years beginning June first, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-one, for the purpose of maintenance.

APPROVED—The 27th day of May, A. D. 1921, in the sum of \$6,000. I withhold my approval from the remainder of said appropriation because of insufficient State revenue.
