### **Preparing for Hospital Fair.**

A special meeting of the Ladies' Auxillary of the Hospital Association will be held to-morrow at 2 p. m. at the rooms, No. 816 Hamilton street, to make arrangements for the fair in May, the proceeds of which will be devoted towards the erection of a wing to the hospital. All members of the auxillary or members of their families who desire to assist, are requested to attend or send their names in order to complete the committees. The plan is to erect a wigwam, 80 by 150 feet, at the northwest corner of Twelfth and Hamilton streets, where the fair will be held for two weeks. The ladies hope to realize \$5000. Their last fair netted \$2800.
