Will of Dr. Alexander Weaver.

The late Dr. Alexander Weaver, of Fifth and Allen streets, in his will left \$1000 each to the Allentown Hospital and to the Orphans' Home, at Topton. Deceased left all his property to his widow during life. At her death it is to be sold and her daughter, Mrs. Ephraim DeLong, gets it all with the exception of the special bequests. Squire W. H. Snyder was named as executor.
