**Stiles' Appropriation Bill Passes
House Committee.**

THE \$20,000 IN SIGHT

**State Senator Harry Stiles' Efforts in
Behalf of the Allentown Hospital
Will Again be Successful—
\$5000 to Furnish New Wing.**

HARRISBURG, June 10.—The bill fathered by Senator Stiles, of Lehigh, appropriating \$20,000 for the Allentown Hospital, which was passed last week by the senate, was reported this evening by the house committee and will come up for first reading to-day. Through the efforts of Senator Stiles the bill, as it will be read before the house to-day, provides for \$15,000 for maintenance and \$5,000 for the furnishing of the new wing of the Allentown Hospital.
